
The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notification of an Abnormal Occurrence as required by Technical Specification 6.6.B.1.a within 24 hours of the occurrence.

At 12:45 a.m. on September 7, 1974, while starting up Unit 2 after testing RCIC and RPCI, suppression chamber water level was +3 inches, thus exceeding the +2.0 inch limit specified in Technical Specification 3.7.A.1.b. Rod pulling was discontinued and draining of suppression chamber was initiated. Zero inch level was reached at 2:15 a.m. and startup was continued.

This occurrence was discussed by telephone with Mr. C. Feierabend of your office on September 9, 1974. Further information will be provided by Abnormal Occurrence Report AO 50-265/74-24 which will be submitted within 10 days of the date of this occurrence.

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
