



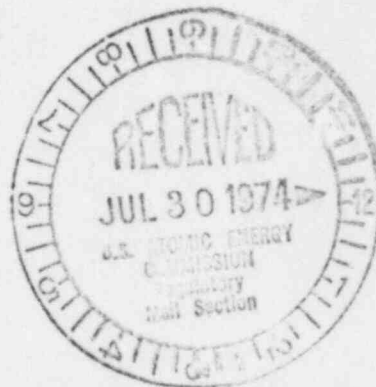

Dear Mr. Keppler:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notification of an Abnormal Occurrence as required by Technical Specification 6.6.B.1.a within 24 hours of the occurrence.

On July 22, 1974, upon recalculation of liquid radioactive waste discharges for the monthly discharge summary, it was discovered that the  $1 \times 10^{-7}$  uCi/ml limit in the discharge bay was violated on three occasions:

6/21/74	$1.38 \times 10^{-7}$ uCi/ml	(including background)
6/21/74	$1.28 \times 10^{-7}$ uCi/ml	(including background)
6/23/74	$1.19 \times 10^{-7}$ uCi/ml	(including background)

The present discharge procedure is being reviewed to eliminate future occurrences.

This occurrence was discussed by telephone with Mr. Feierabend of your office on July 23, 1974. Further information will be provided by Abnormal Occurrence Report AO 50-265/74-18 which will be submitted within 10 days of the date of this occurrence.
