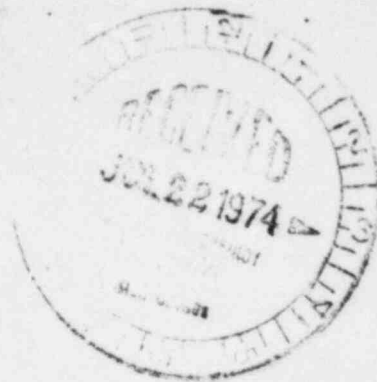

Dear Mr. Keppler:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notification of the above referenced abnormal occurrence as required by Technical Specifications C.C.D.1.c. within 24 hours.

On July 14, 1974 at 2230 hours, it was found that two condensate phase separators and one clean-up phase separator had been decanted into the waste surge tank at about 2000 hrs. on the same day. The waste surge tank was put on recirculation and a sample taken to determine curie inventory. This curie inventory was found to be 5.05 curies. This waste surge tank water immediately began to be reprocessed through the waste collector and filter demineralizer. Curie content was determined to be 2.75 curies at the expiration of the 24 hour period on July 15, 1974, thus exceeding Tech. Spec. 3.8.E.

This abnormal occurrence was discussed with C. Feierabend of Region III in person on July 16, 1974.
