STATE'S MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME
TO FILE RESPONSE TO APPLICANTS' PROPOSED
STANDARD FOR LITIGATING ALLEGATIONS OF
INTIMIDATION

The State of Texas hereby moves the Board to grant it a twenty day enlargement of time in which to file its response to Applicants' Proposed Standard for Litigating Allegations of Intimidation. The requested enlargement would extend the State's filing date from May 23, 1984, until June 12, 1984.

The requested enlargement is necessary to allow counsel for the State to evaluate the proposed standard from the State's perspective in sufficient detail to provide the Board useful assistance in arriving at a sound determination on the issue. The State does not anticipate that any other participant in the licensing proceeding will be prejudiced by this enlargement, especially since the earliest estimated starting date for evidentiary hearings on the allegations of intimidation is July 9, 1984.

Therefore, the State of Texas respectfully moves the Board to enter the attached proposed order enlarging until June 12th the time in which it may file its Response to Applicant's




