Dear Mr. Keppler:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notification of an Abnormal Occurrence as required by Technical Specification 6.6.B.1.a within 24 hours of the occurrence.

On October 20, 1975, while performing monthly calculations of radwaste discharges, it was discovered that Batch 3709, from the Laundry Drain Sample Tank, was discharged on October 4, 1975 at a rate which resulted in an activity in excess of the Technical Specifications limit of 1.0×10^{-7} uCi/ml in the Spray Canal blow-down line. The monthly calculations revealed that the actual radwaste discharge activity in the blowdown line was 4.42×10^{-7} uCi/ml.

This occurrence was discussed by telephone with Mr. Feierabend of your office on October 20, 1975. Further information will be provided by Abnormal Occurrence Report AO 50-254/75-22 which will be submitted within 10 days of the date of this occurrence.
