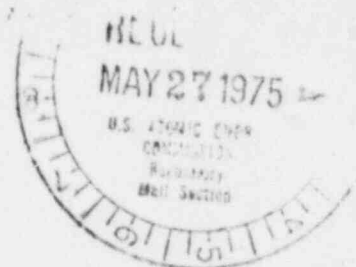

Dear Mr. Keppler:


The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notification of an Abnormal Occurrence as required by Technical Specification 6.6.B.1.a within 24 hours of the occurrence.

On May 22, 1975, while approaching 700 MWe and increasing power with recirc flow and control rod withdrawals, an off-gas high high timer start and subsequent off-gas isolation was received. The load was reduced and the isolation was reset. Preliminary data shows the release rate as measured at the steam jet air ejectors was approximately 300,000 μ ci/sec. This occurrence is being further evaluated at this time.

This occurrence was discussed by telephone with Mr. Knop of your office on May 22, 1975. Further information will be provided by Abnormal Occurrence Report AO 50-265/75-17 which will be submitted within 10 days of the date of this occurrence.
