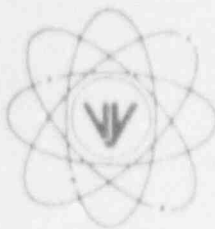


Subject: Licensed Operator Requalification Program - Re-evaluation

The purpose of this letter is to formally request that the NRC conduct a re-evaluation of Vermont Yankee's licensed operator requalification program. We propose February 10 through 14 in 1992 to examine two operating crews (A and E) and one staff crew.
