

In a letter dated June 30, 1982, from Mr. J. H. Goldberg to Mr. Brian Grimes, Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) committed to provide a schedule for the implementation of the South Texas Project Prompt Notification System by July 1983. This letter addresses the subject schedule.
