Dear Mr. Congel:

Enclosed is a copy of the final exercise report for the July 25, 1990, joint exercise of the offsite radiological emergency response plans site-specific to the Clinton Nuclear Power Plant. The State of Illinois and the Support Counties of Macon, McLean, and Piatt partially participated in the exercise. DeWitt County, as well as the Illinois Power Company, fully participated in the exercise. The exercise report, dated June 7, 1991, was prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region V staff and copies of the report will be provided to the State of Illinois.

There were no Deficiencies identified during the July 25, 1990, exercise. However, the exercise report identifies two Areas Requiring Corrective Action. A schedule of corrective actions has been provided by the State of Illinois in response to the exercise weaknesses identified. Additional verification will be provided by FEMA Region V during the next exercise for the Clinton Nuclear Power Plant, now scheduled for November 4, 1992.

Based on the results of the July 25, 1990, exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the Clinton Nuclear Power Plant are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site. Therefore, the Title 44 CFR, Part 350 approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness site-specific to the Clinton Nuclear Power Plant granted August 3, 1987, continues to be in effect.
