EXPOSURE OF OUTSIDE CONTRACTOR PERSONNEL HAVE NOT BEEN REPORTED TO THE AEC OR TO THE INDIVIDUALS AS REQUIRED IN 10CFR20.408 AND 20.409. THE CIRCUMSTANCES BEHIND THIS OVERSIGHT ON THE PART OF CP CO HAVE BEEN VARIED AND DIVERSE. FOLLOWING ARE SOME RAMIFICATIONS OF THE REPORTING PROBLEMS.

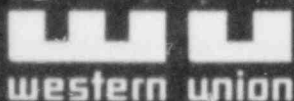
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1. COMBUSTION ENGINEERING "CE" HAS STATED THAT CP CO DOES NOT NEED TO REPORT EXPOSURES TO THEIR PERSONNEL AS THEY MAINTAIN THEIR OWN PERSONNEL DOSIMETRY PROGRAM. THUS CP CO HAS NEVER REPORTED CE PERSONNEL EXPOSURES TO THE AEC. CE HAS IN THE PAST RECEIVED A COPY OF OUR FILM BADGE REPORTS AS VERIFICATION OF PERSONNEL EXPOSURES. THE BOILERMAKERS AND PIPEFITTERS USED FOR RECENT STEAM GENERATOR REPAIRS WERE NOT NOTIFIED AFTER THE FIRST PLUGGING AND FLUSHING OPERATIONS, THE REASONING WAS THAT WE WERE NOT SURE SUCH REPORTS WERE NECESSARY AS THESE PERSONNEL WERE ALSO EMPLOYED BY CE. CONSEQUENTLY HOME ADDRESSES FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL WERE NOT OBTAINED AS A PART OF THEIR REQUIREMENT TO WORK UNDER OUR LICENSE.

MR. FISCHER WAS CONTACTED TO OBTAIN HIS OPINION ON POSSIBLE NOTIFICATION OF THE OUTSIDE PERSONNEL THROUGH THEIR UNION LOCAL DUE TO

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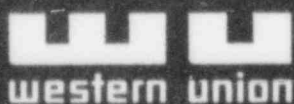
THE LARGE NUMBER OF NEW INVOLVED. HE INDICATED THAT THIS PROCEDURE SHOULD HAVE BEEN USED ONLY IF AGREED TO PRIOR TO WORK ASSIGNMENT AND ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS.

IN THE FUTURE, ALL WORK TERMINATIONS COVERED IN CFR 20.405 AND 409 WILL BE REPORTED TO THE AEC AND THE EXPOSED INDIVIDUAL.

THE FOLLOWING CORRECTIVE ACTIONS HAVE BEEN INDICATED:

1. A FORM IS NOW IN USE THAT WILL ENCOMPASS TO CFR 19 AND 20 INDOCTRINATIONS. AEC FORM 4 REQUIRES THE HOME ADDRESS OF ALL PERSONNEL WORKING THE LICENSEE'S INSTALLATION. THIS FORM WILL BE SIGNED BY THE INDIVIDUAL.

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2. A PROCEDURE WILL BE WRITTEN AND IMPLEMENTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE ON REPORTING OF EXPOSURE TO THE AEC AND THE INDIVIDUAL.
3. PAST EXPOSURES TO PERSONNEL WILL BE REPORTED TO THE AEC AND THE INDIVIDUAL AS SOON AS THE INDIVIDUAL ADDRESSES ARE OBTAINED. AS OF THIS WRITING, 95 PERCENT OF THE ADDRESSES HAVE BEEN OBTAINED.

WE REQUEST ADDITIONAL CLARIFICATION ON THIS MATTER IF THE CORRECTIVE ACTION OUTLINED WILL NOT SUFFICE.
