SUBJECT: AP600 STEAM GENERATOR AUDIT


Dear Mr. Quay:

In response to your February 14, 1995 request to perform an audit of " ...the new Westinghouse Delta 75 steam generators ...", a copy of a procurement specification used in an actual Delta 75 steam generator procurement has been placed in the Westinghouse Rockville Nuclear Licensing Center. The NRC has approved this specific Delta 75 application and the plant is currently in operation.

As discussed with Ms. Shembarger of your staff, the February 14, 1995 letter included several items, such as a request to provide the sample welder qualification records, review of the travelers for the tube-to-tubesheet welds, a review of the NDE drawings and a determination of the location where the forging is performed, that are clearly not design certification review activities since these would require that the AP600 steam generator have been constructed. This is beyond the intent of 10 CFR 52.47(a)(2).

Westinghouse suggests that the need behind the requests in the February 14, 1995 letter may be satisfied by reviewing prior NRC activities associated with specific Delta 75 steam generator manufacture, installation and operation.
