1992 NORTH ANNA ANNUAL EMERGENCY EXERCISE

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our decision to announce the date of the upcoming North Anna Emergency Exercise. The current exercise scope submitted to you on October 14, 1991, indicated our intention to conduct the exercise unannounced. This action was discussed with NRC Region II staff earlier this week.

The decision to announce the exercise is based on the need to allow proper scheduling of resources associated with the unplanned North Anna Steam Generator inspection outage. Additionally, the Commonwealth of Virginia has received a waiver from FEMA for their exercise to be unannounced based upon the Alert emergency that took place on February 25, 1989. A copy of correspondence from the State to Virginia Electric and Power Company is enclosed for your reference.



The Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region III Office, Philadelphia has verbally notified me that the Commonwealth of Virginia, its responsible state agencies, and the five local governments within the ten-mile emergency planning zone of the North Anna Power Station have been granted a waiver exempting these entities from the requirement to conduct an "unannounced, off-hours exercise" in this planning cycle. We expect a written confirmation to this effect within the next few days. The North Anna Power Station full-scale exercise will be conducted on January 15, 1992.
