Enclosed is Revision 1 to the Inservice Inspection Program (SON SI-114.1) for unit 1 at the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant. This revision is being submitted to provide additional changes resulting from implementation of the inservice inspection program, as requested by the April 14, 1980 letter from Charles E. Murphy to H. G. Parris.

The inservice and inspection program, SI-114.1 is applicable for our Sequoyah Nuclear Plant unit 1 only and outlines the requirements for performing the first 10-year interval inservice nondestructive examinations for ASME Code Class 1, 2, and 3 components containing water, steam, or radioactive material. The inservice and inspection program is based on the 1977 Edition and Summer 1978 Addenda of Section XI of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code A.
