Gentlemen:

- Reference: a. Letter, D. G. Eisenhower to All Licensees of Operating  
Reactors et. al, "Required Actions Based on Generic  
Implications of Salem ATWS Events (Generic Letter 83-  
28)," July 8, 1983
- b. IP Letter U-0660, August 31, 1983

Reference (a) requested the submittal of status, positions, plans, and schedules for licensee actions to resolve the issues associated with the Salem ATWS events. Reference (b) discussed the then-current status of Clinton Power Station (CPS) with regard to these issues, and presented preliminary plans for the submittal of the information that would be responsive to Generic Letter 83-28.

Illinois Power Company (IP) is addressing the issues of Generic Letter 83-28 by using in part methodologies being developed by industry groups established to investigate those issues. IP has participated in the deliberations of the Boiling Water Reactor Owners Group (BWROG) Salem ATWS Generic Issues Committee, the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO) Nuclear Task Action Committee (NUTAC) for Generic Letter 83-28 Section 2.2.2, and the BWROG Technical Specifications Improvement Subcommittee. However, the final reports of these groups are not yet available. Therefore, we were not able to submit the information by February 29, 1984.

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
