Gentlemen:

This refers to your letter transmitted on April 19, 1995 in regard to the Long-Term Performance Improvement Program (LTPIP) Meeting held on April 10, 1995. In this letter you discussed the corrective actions implemented as a result of the inappropriate transfer of some control room functions to the remote shutdown panel during a surveillance test on February 28, 1995. The letter stated that *"these corrective actions include the development of impact statements accompanying work items that will be developed by personnel with an operating license."*

While these impact statements are currently being developed by licensed or previously licensed individuals, the intent of this corrective action is to ensure that the individuals developing these statements have the integrated plant knowledge to ensure plant impact is adequately addressed. These individuals will not necessarily have an operating license but will have the necessary experience and skill as determined by the Operations Department to develop impact statements for preventive maintenance work packages.
