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

Proposed Revision to the Industrial Security Plan  
Concerning Alternative Compensatory Measures

Gentlemen:

By letter dated February 2, 1995 (OCNA029502), the Staff documented their review of changes to the Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO) Industrial Security Plan (ISP) which added flexibility for the use of alternate compensatory measures for a failure of the perimeter detection and assessment equipment. The Staff approved these changes contingent on specified stipulations and requested page change revisions to the ISP. A meeting was held on March 16, 1995, in order to clarify the Staff's stipulations. A description of the proposed ISP changes and specific page change revisions to the ANO ISP are attached.
