
PECO Energy Company (PECO Energy) has determined that a revision to the dates of the second Inservice Inspection (ISI) interval for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station (PBAPS) Unit, 3 is needed to effectively implement the requirements of Section XI of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code. The revision is necessary to allow the end of the interval to envelope a scheduled refueling outage.

In accordance with 10CFR50.55a(g)(4), the second interval ISI program for PBAPS, Unit 3 conforms to the 1980 Edition of the Code through Winter 1981 addenda. This edition permits an interval to be extended or decreased by as much as one year to allow for outage correlation (paragraph IWA-2400(c)).

As indicated in Reference 1, the second ISI interval dates for PBAPS, Unit 3 were revised to the time period of December 23, 1985 to August 14, 1997 to account for an extended outage on that unit and to reconcile adjustments made to the first and second interval lengths (Reference 2). The unit's eleventh refueling outage is presently scheduled to occur during the September, 1997 to October, 1997 time frame. Because the Code permits the ISI interval to be adjusted for extended outages and permits an additional adjustment by as much as one year for outage correlation, the second ISI interval will be extended to envelope the eleventh refueling outage, and to align with the PBAPS, Unit 2 end of the second interval, which is presently scheduled for November 4, 1997.
