- Changes identified in the annual "Report of Facility Changes, Tests and Experiments." This report is being submitted separately under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.59.
- NRC approved changes associated with the implementation of Regulatory Guides 1.58 and 1.88.
- Changes to the description of reactor vessel head flange leakage monitoring in accordance with Technical Specification Change Request No. 211/Amendment No. 183.
- The description of the Onsite Meteorological Monitoring Program has been replaced by reference to the Unit 2 FSAR.
- Editorial changes intended to correct or clarify the text and figures of the FSAR.






