Request for IPEEE Submittal Extension


Gentlemen:

Generic Letter 88-20 Supplement 4 requested an evaluation of the vulnerability of nuclear plants to certain specified external events (IPEEE). By letter dated September 18, 1992 Georgia Power Company indicated that the Individual Plant Examination External Events (IPEEE) submittal would be provided by June 1995. GPC requests an extension of the schedule for the IPEEE submittal to January 31, 1996.

This request is necessitated by the engineering work performed in response to the qualification of Thermo-Lag fire barrier material issue. This re-engineering, only recently completed, precluded the analytical work necessary to produce a probabilistic evaluation of the plant risk due to fire. Consequently, the IPEEE will not be available for submittal until the later part of this year.
