Dear Sir:

Per the request of Mr. L. Bender of your staff, we would like to note that the following items are addressed by our training program:

- (1) Coordinated training of the plant fire brigade and the local fire department is provided so that responsibilities and duties are delineated in advance. This coordination is part of the training course and is included in the training of the local fire department staff.
- (2) Local fire departments are provided training in operational precautions when fighting fires on nuclear power plant sites and are made aware of the need for radiological protection of personnel and the special hazards associated with a nuclear power plant site.
- (3) Reactor Operator and Senior Reactor Operator training shall include the subjects specified in 10 CFR 55.21 and 55.22, and the Training for Mitigating Core Damage specified in FSAR Section 13.2.2.4.
- (4) The Operator Requalification program shall meet the requirements of 10 CFR 55 Appendix A. Specifically, the program shall include the lectures specified by paragraph 2 of Appendix A; on-the-job training shall include at least 10 reactivity control manipulations as specified by paragraph 3 of Appendix A; records shall be maintained in accordance with paragraph 5 of Appendix A.
