Vendor Review of Emergency Operating Procedures (EOPs)

Dear Sir:

As you are aware, Waterford 3 emergency operating procedures (EOPs) were developed using the Combustion Engineering Emergency Procedure Guidelines (EPGs) as their basis.

The subject TMI Action Item requires vendor review of plant EOPs. In response to this requirement LP&L, in FSAR section 1.9.14, agreed to obtain vendor review of the Waterford 3 EOPs.

It is now our understanding, from a conversation with your Mr. M. Goodman (NRR/PTRB), that those plants utilizing vendor generic EPGs as the basis for EOPs have met the I.C.7 requirement for vendor review. Based on this discussion we believe that our commitment for vendor review of EOPs has been fulfilled and we will not be initiating a separate formal vendor review.
