Subject: Clarification of TMI Action Plan Item
II.K.3.31

Generic Letter 83-35 dated November 2, 1983 requested Detroit Edison to submit plant specific small-break-loss-of-coolant accident (SBLOCA) analyses using evaluation models revised per II.K.3.30 to meet the requirements of NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.31.

Reference (2) GE Letter submitted to the NRC, demonstrated that the current GE small break LOCA model was acceptable relative to II.K.3.30 and that no model change was required. The NRC reference 3 agreed with this conclusion.

Accordingly, Detroit Edison considers that no further action on TMI items II.K.3.30 and II.K.3.31 is necessary and these items may be considered resolved.

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
