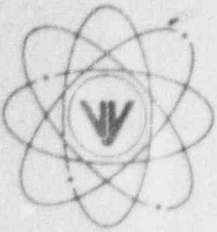

As a member of the BWR Vessel and Internals Project (BWRVIP), Vermont Yankee plans to implement the plan of action described in Reference (c). Vermont Yankee intends to use the information gathered by the BWRVIP to develop a response to remaining Generic Letter requests 2, 3 and 4 as discussed in Reference (b).
