GEORGIA POWER COMPANY'S FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO
INTERVENOR'S FIFTH INTERROGATORY AND DOCUMENT REQUEST

Georgia Power Company ("GPC") hereby supplements its Response to Intervenor's Fifth Interrogatory and Document Request, dated July 22, 1994 (the "Georgia Power's Response to Intervenor's Fifth Request"). Specifically, this response supplements Georgia Power's prior response to Interrogatory No. 7. This supplemental response incorporates all of the objections raised in the prior response.


Georgia Power's response to Interrogatory No. 7 stated that "Mr. Kochery recalls that someone may have told him that water was discovered in the 2" air start line, but does not recall who told him." Georgia Power's Response to Intervenor's Fifth Request at 4. Upon review of his deposition at the suggestion of the Board (Tr. 10544-45), Mr. Kochery determined that his response to Intervenor's questions was partially incorrect. While Mr. Kochery correctly stated that he was not aware of liquid coming from trip lines, he

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incorrectly stated that liquid was discovered in an air start line. The event he was recalling was the discovery of water in the diesel combustion air intake line located below the diesel engine intercooler. See Corrected Deposition of Paul Kochery dated July 6, 1994 at Tr. 38-39.

9 Q Do you remember seeing a jar with
10 some fluid in it in your office?

11 A No.

12 Q Do you remember seeing any container
13 with fluid in it that someone brought in your
14 office?

15 A No, I don't remember.

16 Q Specifically do you remember Mr.
17 Burr, Mr. Stokes or Mr. Chenault talking to you
18 about or leaving a container with fluid in it in
19 your office?

20 A No.

21 Q Were you aware of liquid coming out
22 of the trip lines?

23 A No. I remember it coming from the
24 *air start line, not the trip line.

25 Q What is the air start line?

1 A Two inch ^{The} big line, air line.
2 Q And what do you remember about it?
3 What line or when was it collected?
4 A The line to drain it.
5 Q Can you tell me when?
6 A Sometime during the time, I believe.
7 Q During the time of the Critique Team?
8 A I don't think it was during the
9 Critique Team time. Sometime --

11 Team?

20 were having problems with the air start valves?

22 time period was it.






