FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

To whom it may concern:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, as amended, the Nuclear Information and Resource Service requests the following documents regarding the Wolf Creek Nuclear Power plant. Please consider "documents" to include reports, studies, test results, correspondence, memoranda, meeting notes, meeting minutes, working papers, graphs, charts, diagrams, notes and summaries of conversations and interviews, computer records, and any other forms of written communication, including internal NRC Staff memoranda. The documents are specifically requested from, but not limited to, the following offices of the NRC: Office of the Analysis and Evaluation of Operational Data (AEOD); Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR); Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (Research); Office of Inspection and Enforcement (I&E); Generic Issues Branch of the Division of Safety Technology, NRR; and the Operating Reactors Branches of the Division of Licensing. In your response, please identify which documents correspond to which requests below.

Pursuant to this request, please provide all documents prepared or utilized by, in the possession of, or routed through the NRC related to:

1. Allegations and subsequent inspections and investigations made in 1981 regarding the falsification of Quality Assurance/Quality Control documents by Mike Annas, general foreman for the Daniels Construction Company, a division of Daniels International at the Wolf Creek facility; and
2. Any investigations made by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) related to such allegations of falsification.

In our opinion, it is appropriate in this case for you to waive copying and search charges, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A) "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public." The Nuclear
