NRC IE BULLETIN NO. 83-07 DATED JULY 22, 1983
APPARENTLY FRAUDULENT PRODUCTS SOLD BY RAY MILLER, INC.
HOPE CREEK GENERATING STATION

In reply to the subject NRC IE Bulletin, we offer the following at this time:

Bechtel, our Architect Engineer, has identified 47 San Francisco Home Office purchase orders that could contain material similar in type to that provided by Ray Miller, Inc. Bechtel also identified 12 suppliers of ASME Section III fittings and piping who received Field Purchase Orders. Bechtel contacted all of the suppliers who received these Home Office and Field Purchase Orders to determine if they supplied any material provided by Ray Miller, Inc.

Replies were received from all except two suppliers, affirming that they provided no material from Ray Miller, Inc. For the two suppliers who did not respond, Bechtel will conduct a field investigation of the suppliers' documentation to determine whether Ray Miller, Inc. material was used. We will advise you of the results of this investigation by May 31, 1984. Should additional information be desired before that date, we will be pleased to discuss it with you.
