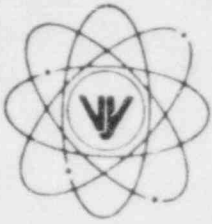

Subject: Response to I&E Bulletin 83-07, Apparently Fraudulent Products
Sold by Ray Miller, Inc.

In response to Reference b), a detailed search was conducted of the Operational Quality Assurance vendor files for all companies listed in the I&E Bulletin and supplements thereto. In addition, letters of inquiry were sent to specific vendors to determine whether any of the subject materials may have been supplied by the vendors or their sub-tier vendors. No evidence was found that any of the subject material was supplied either directly or indirectly by Ray Miller, Inc. for use at the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station.

Furthermore, as discussed in Reference c), we have completed a comprehensive review of our existing Quality Assurance Program and, having determined that the general concerns of the Bulletin (e.g., the potential for fraudulent vendor practices) do apply to Vermont Yankee, we have concluded that certain programmatic enhancements are desirable. Accordingly, we intend to upgrade our existing program in the areas of vendor selection and product acceptance to include criteria for assessing, respectively, the ability of vendors to identify and prevent fraud, and the authenticity of products received at Vermont Yankee. These measures are expected to be implemented by September 1, 1984.

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

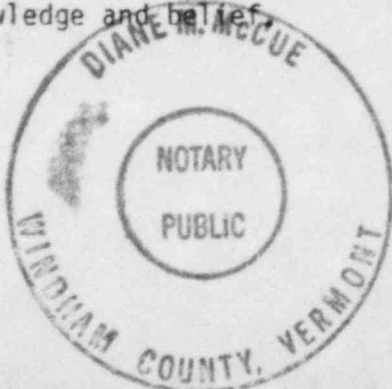


