SUPPLEMENT TO SUFFOLK COUNTY'S PRELIMINARY VIEWS  
ON SCHEDULING REGARDING LILCO'S NEW MOTION

On March 29, 1984, the NRC Staff held a public meeting with LILCO to discuss technical aspects of LILCO's new motion for a low power operating license. A copy of the transcript of that meeting is attached for the convenience of the Board.

This Board clearly indicated in its February 22, 1984 oral order that any proposal submitted by LILCO for a low power license must not rely on the TDI EDGs. This Board then stated, "[W]e don't have any confidence that any of these [TDI] diesels will operate at any power unless we have litigated Contentions 1, 2 and 3 on the merits." (Tr. 21,631). Notwithstanding the Board's order, at the March 29 meeting LILCO representatives explicitly indicated that LILCO's new motion relies solely upon the TDI diesels for onsite emergency power. See March 29 transcript at 39-45, 46-48.

Suffolk County previously noted that LILCO's new proposal does not comply with GDC 17, that serious questions exist as to whether it complies with GDC 2, 4, 5, 18 and 50, 10 C.F.R. Part 50, Appendix B, and that LILCO has neither filed for a waiver from the requirements of NRC regulations nor provided any significant grounds for this Board's consideration of LILCO's new motion. See Suffolk County's Preliminary Views on Scheduling Regarding LILCO's New Motion, March 26, 1984. Now that LILCO has expressly admitted that it is relying solely on the TDI diesels for onsite emergency power with respect to its new motion, this Board should summarily dismiss that motion.
