Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(w)(4), Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) hereby submits the following required information concerning CP&L's present level and source of onsite property damage insurance.

Carolina Power & Light Company has in full force and effect at both the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant Unit No. 2 (HBR2) and Brunswick Steam Electric Plant Units No. 1 and 2 (BSEP) property insurance in the amount of \$500,000,000 with Nuclear Mutual Limited covering the period April 1, 1983 to April 1, 1984. This coverage will be renewed effective April 1, 1984 for the period April 1, 1984 to April 1, 1985.

Carolina Power & Light Company also has in full force and effect at both HBR2 and BSEP excess nuclear property insurance in the amount of \$435,000,000 with Nuclear Electric Insurance Limited (NEIL) covering the period November 15, 1983 to November 15, 1984.
