By copy of this letter, the Seabrook Technical Specifications are also being submitted to USNRC Region I for their use in preparation of Seabrook Station Operator Licensing examinations, currently scheduled to be given in the Fall of 1984. Any revisions made to this document will not be included in the initial Operator License Training Program. However, these revisions will be reflected in the Seabrook Station Operator Licensing Requalification Program which is scheduled for implementation immediately subsequent to completion of the operator licensing examinations.


