Elected officials in the City of Harrisburg went to the Public Hearings in 1981 before the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency to protest changes in evacuation plans for Harrisburg which leaves 90% of our residents unprotected and not planned for in the event of evacuation, resulting from radiation-related emergencies at Three Mile Island.

Our pleadings fell on deaf ears, and since that time we have been asked to, again, approve such a feeble, inadequate plan for our community.

Rather than continuing to take no action, City Council, on March 6, 1984, officially REJECTED the proposed emergency plan. That plan is an injustice which none of us will condone.

We are now asking that all involved parties at the City, County, State and Federal levels consider our concerns.

We have asked the City Solicitor to explore our legal ability to prevent restart at TMI due to the absence of a radiological emergency evacuation plan, and we intend to pursue those avenues to protect our citizens.

You exercise power over decisions relating to this situation. We urge you to do what you can to assist us.
