This letter provides confirmation of a commitment as requested by the NRC staff in regards to their approval of a Peach Bottom License Amendment. The Commission on February 24, 1984, issued Amendments Nos. 92 and 94 to the Operating License Nos. DPR-44 and DPR-56 for Peach Bottom Units 2 and 3, respectively. The License Amendment transmittal letter requests the Licensee to notify the Regional Administrator, with a copy to the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, of any changes to the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and of any permit violations.
