

The individual is now on a company Follow Up Monitoring Program.

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS

Our Quality Assurance Audit completed in November 1991 indicated no weaknesses in our FPD program. Some strengths observed were that all procedures and protocols for onsite lab testing for alcohol and illegal drugs conformed to 10CFR26 requirements. All blind performance tests and random testing are being done meeting requirements of percentage and selection for testing.

Notes * Clinton Power tests all site employees with or without unescorted access. The Average Site Population for Clinton in 1991 was 1600 employees.

** Those placed on a monitoring program per the Medical Review Officers recommendation due to background information and personal interviews by the MRO during entrance processing.
