Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10CFR50.54(q), TU Electric herewith submits Revision 13 of the CPSES Emergency Plan (EP). Revision 13 provides updates, revisions, corrections, additions, clarifications and editorial changes. These changes were evaluated and determined to not decrease the effectiveness of the existing plans. Changes are indicated by a Revision 13 change bar. A detailed description, provided as Attachment 2, discusses changes indicated by the change bar. The following is a general summary of the changes included in this revision to the CPSES Emergency Plan:

1. Updated Table of Contents to reflect revised section, table and figure titles.
2. Revised and relocated plans describing corporate office emergency response and support. Plans were deleted from Appendix S and relocated into the main body of the CPSES Emergency Plan. The details of implementing corporate office support were deleted from related Corporate Emergency Response Procedures and incorporated into a new CPSES Emergency Plan Procedure.
3. Revised plan with respect to departmental reorganization and updated what plant personnel are responsible for providing Security, Fire Brigade and First Aid/Rescue duties.
4. Revised plan with respect to general instructions for relocating personnel from the primary Operations Support Center (OSC) or News Center under severe accident conditions.
5. Revised figures related to the Emergency Response Facility Computer System and Digital Radiation Monitoring System.

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6. Revised Appendices to update implementing procedure title list and a supporting letter of agreement.

Please be advised that as a result of changes associated with item (2) above, the Corporate Emergency Response Procedures Manual as originally docketed under the reference above has been retired. Accordingly, existing copies of the Corporate Emergency Response Procedures should be destroyed.



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
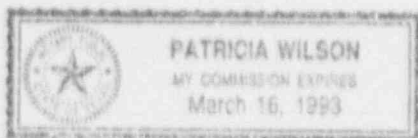
