
I have reviewed your request for public disclosure of proprietary information contained within WCAP-12613, Revision 2, entitled "RTD Bypass Elimination Licensing Report for J. M. Farley Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2". Specifically, the proprietary nature of the information presented in Table 2.1-1 was reviewed by the Westinghouse technical disciplines which generate and utilize the information.

The subject information has been classified as proprietary in accordance with designations (a) and (c) from Affidavit CAW-91-118. These designations refer to:

- (a) distinguishing aspects of a process (or component, structure, tool, method, etc.) where prevention of its use by any of Westinghouse's competitors without license from Westinghouse constitutes a competitive economic advantage over other companies, and
- (b) use by a competitor which would reduce his expenditure of resources or improve his competitive position in the design, manufacture, shipment, installation, assurance of quality, or licensing a similar product.

We have concluded that Table 2.1-1 can be released to the public without any significant harm to our competitive advantage in safety analysis methodology.
