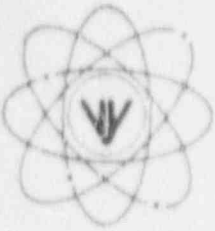

Subject: Revision 21 to the Vermont Yankee Physical Security Plan

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with Revision No. 21 to the Vermont Yankee Physical Security Plan. This revision reflects enhancements recently made to our Security Program. These changes were previously incorporated into our implementing procedures and the enclosure reflects the resultant Plan changes.

We have reviewed this revision and have determined that the changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the Plan. Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p), prior NRC approval of this revision is not required.


