Subject: Fire Hazard Analysis Report Binder Recall - Second Notice

The Fire Hazard Analysis Report (FHAR), Amendment 8, has been reproduced in its entirety and was distributed on November 6, 1991, in burgundy binders. This FHAR supercedes the FHAP information in the tan binders.

On November 15, 1991, a memo was issued to Distribution with instructions to destroy the superceded FHAR information in the tan binders and to return the tan binders to document control. To date, some recalled binders have not been returned and superceded information is still being used. This is a configuration control concern. Please ensure that the superceded FHAR information has been discarded and the binders returned to Document Control.
