Security Storage Containers


Dear Mr. Denton:

In accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 73.21 (10CFR73.21), South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G) is required to store safeguards information within security storage containers as defined in 10CFR73.2 (mm). To meet this requirement, SCE&G is utilizing fire resistant filing cabinets with a one (1) hour fire rating that are equipped with Sergeant and Greenleaf three (3) position changeable combination locks.

Through a joint engineering and security assessment, SCE&G has determined that these fire resistant, combination lock filing cabinets provide more than adequate physical protection to meet the safeguards information storage requirements as stated in Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations. These cabinets also offer an equivalent degree of traceability relative to forcible entry as do the steel filing cabinets equipped with steel locking bars and changeable combination padlocks specifically described in 10CFR73.21.
