Training and Qualification Plan - Revision 11

By letter L-91-253, dated October 14, 1991, Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) submitted to the NRC Revision 11 to the Turkey Point Training and Qualification (T&Q) Plan. As a result of the review performed by the NRC, several changes were requested to clarify the changes made in Revision 11 of the Turkey Point T&Q Plan. The changes identified during the review process have been incorporated into a "revised" Revision 11 of the Turkey Point T&Q Plan. As no training affected by the previously submitted Revision 11 to the Turkey Point T&Q Plan, has been implemented, the previously submitted Revision 11 is withdrawn and the attached "revised" Revision 11 replaces it in its entirety.

FPL has determined that the revision does not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(p). Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.4 (b)(4), a description of the revision and copies PTNTQP-R11-3 through PTNTQP-R11-6 of the plan are enclosed:

Enclosure 1: Summary of the changes.

Enclosure 2: Directions for incorporating this revision into the plan, and copies of the replacement pages.

By copy of this letter, we are forwarding copies PTNTQP-R11-1 and 2 to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region 11.
