In this portion of the testimony, Mr. Schiffmacher answered certain questions about FSAR Table 8.1.7-1 posed by Suffolk County counsel. Mr. Schiffmacher indicated that he was not familiar with the table and LILCO indicated that it would supply an appropriate witness. Tr. 347. During the final recess on April 25 prior to the suspension of hearings, counsel for LILCO and the County agreed that it would not be necessary to provide further explanation of the table if the above testimony was struck. Counsel were not able to communicate their agreement to the Board prior to suspension of the hearings.

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
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
