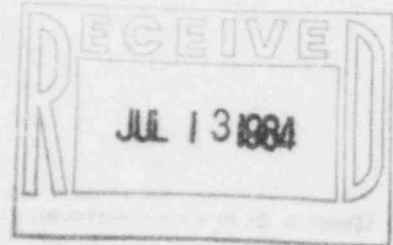

Dear Sir:

In accordance with the provisions of 10CFR50.55(f)(3) the attached change to Table 17A-1 of the CPSES FSAR is submitted. This change is an editorial change to remove an apparent inconsistency. The safety classification and description "1E" was improperly used to describe the cable trays, conduit and the supports for cable trays and conduit that contain Class 1E wires and cables. The safety classification of Class 1E does not apply to cable trays, conduit and their supports which are support structures and not electrical equipment. This change does not reduce the commitments of the CPSES quality assurance program. Approval to make this change was received from your staff and is documented by attachment (2).

SUBJECT COMANCHE PEAK STEAM ELECTRIC STATION  
CHANGES TO CHAPTER 17 OF FSAR

SUMMARY I called Mr. Hunnicutt to get NRC Region IV approval to make two  
changes to Table 17A-1 of the CPSES FSAR (a change request on the leak testing  
of instrument tubing and a clarification on the safety classification of cable  
trays and their supports).

I asked who I should speak to for approval to changes to Chapter 17 of the  
CPSES FSAR. I explained that I had two fairly minor changes to the table in  
Chapter 17. I also explained that we previously obtained such approvals from  
Dan Fox but understood that he had changed positions.

Mr. Hunnicutt told me to go ahead and make the changes on his authority and that  
he would get back to me in the next several days with the name of our new  
contact for these matters.
