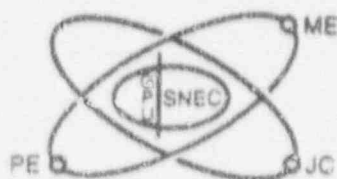

Enclosed, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.4(b)(1), Technical Specification Change Request (TSCR) No. 53, Revision 2 is forwarded for your approval. The purpose of the TSCR is to request removal of the Saxton Nuclear Experimental Corporation (SNEC) facility reactor support buildings and structures from the Technical Specifications (TS). The reactor support buildings and structures consist of the Control and Auxiliary (C&A) building, the Radioactive Waste Disposal Facility (RWDF) building, the Refueling Water Storage Tank (RWST), the earthen Filled Drum Storage Area, and the Pipe Tunnel. The Containment Vessel is not affected by this TSCR.

Also enclosed is one (1) signed copy of the Certificate of Service for this request to the Chief Executives of the Township and County in which the facility is located.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91(a)(1), we have also enclosed an analysis in support of our determination of no significant hazards consideration. Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91(b), a copy of this letter and the proposed change and supporting analysis which indicates no significant hazards consideration have been provided to Mr. William P. Dornsife, the designated representative of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Additionally, we have also enclosed SNEC's responses to the NRC's February 6, 1992 Request for Additional Information.

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
