

Decontamination Liability, Decommissioning Liability and Excess Property Damage Insurance is also provided by Nuclear Electric Insurance Limited ("NEIL") Policy No. X91-014. The Effective Recovery Limit under this policy, effective November 15, 1991, is \$1.250 billion in excess of \$500 million.
