Additional Proposed Change to the
Operating Licenses and Technical
Specifications Fire Protection Requirements

Gentlemen:

In letter OCAN109102, dated October 15, 1991, Entergy Operations submitted for your review and approval proposed Operating Licenses (OLs) and Technical Specifications (TSs) changes revising the Arkansas Nuclear One, Units 1 and 2 (ANO-1&2) OLs and TSs. The proposed changes to the OLs were to add the NRC's standard OL condition for Fire Protection. The proposed changes to the TSs would relocate the Fire Protection requirements from the TSs to the respective Safety Analysis Reports (SARs). These changes were prepared in accordance with Generic Letters 86-10 and 88-12.

During a recent telephone conversation with the NRR Project Manager for ANO-2, it was noted that the ANO-2 Fire Protection Technical Specification Bases were not proposed to be deleted as part of the October 15, 1991, submittal. Attached are the proposed changes to the ANO-2 Technical Specification Bases with regard to the Fire Protection requirements. The bases will be incorporated into the ANO-2 SAR in Amendment 10. Amendment 10 is currently scheduled to be submitted on July 22, 1992.

Entergy Operations has also noted that Technical Specifications 6.12.5 and 6.9.2, "Special Reports" for ANO-1&2, respectively, references applicable specifications for the individual special reports. With the relocation of the fire protection requirements, the referenced specifications for the inoperable fire detection and suppression systems are no longer applicable. Entergy Operations did not propose to delete these references as part of the October 15, 1991, submittal. Attached are the proposed changes to the ANO-1&2 Technical Specifications.

These additional changes do not alter the "No Significant Hazards Considerations" determination provided in the October 15, 1991, submittal.
