

EXTENSION OF SCHEDULE GIVEN IN
INSPECTION REPORT 91-23

Gentlemen:

In our response to Inspection Report 91-23, dated December 3, 1991, GPC committed to revise the Plant Hatch Unit 2 Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) to reflect the actual operation of the main control room environmental control (MCREC) system during the first quarterly update for 1992. GPC also committed to revise MCREC system operating procedure, 3450-Z41-001-1s, to conform to the revised FSAR. As part of GPC's action to comply with this commitment, additional performance testing has been identified as being necessary to achieve complete and final closure of the issues identified in Inspection Report 91-23. These previously unidentified tests will address the potential single failure of various MCREC system components and their effect on the ability of the system to achieve and maintain the required pressure during the pressurization mode of operation.

Because of our desire to address this issue comprehensively, a schedule extension to our previous commitment is necessary. After obtaining and evaluating the test results, the appropriate FSAR sections and the MCREC operating procedure will be revised to reflect actual system operation. The appropriate sections of the Unit 2 FSAR will be revised during our annual update submittal due by the end of July 1992. The procedure will be revised by July 31, 1992.
