

I am writing in regards to "Intervenors Motion to Compel Production of Affidavits in the Possession of Georgia Power Company." On page 7, in the top paragraph which carries over from page 6, item number "5" presently reads: "[Mr. Aufdenkampe] allowed Mr. Mosbaugh to physically review a copy of an affidavit prepared by GPC's counsel."

Mrs. Aufdenkampe offered this review to Mr. Mosbaugh and she expressed concern over the pressure GPC's lawyers were exerting upon her husband relative to the affidavit.
