Gentlemen:

SUBJECT: New Abnormal Operating Procedure (AOP) to Provide Operator Guidance
When The Emergency Response Facility (ERF) Computer is Off-line

In Licensee Event Report 91-023 (Reference 2), Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) committed to develop an AOP by March 1, 1992 that would provide operators with specific guidance and corrective actions to be taken when the ERF computer is off-line. The AOP being developed is AOP-34, "Loss of the ERF Computer."

OPPD is currently updating the format of the Fort Calhoun Station (FCS) AOPs, with a scheduled completion date of June 30, 1992. In order to initially implement the new AOP-34 in the updated format, OPPD requests that the Reference 2 commitment date be changed to June 30, 1992. Mr. R. P. Mullikin of NRC Region IV agreed with this extension in a telephone call on January 15, 1992 with Mr. G. M. Cook of OPPD.
