REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF RESPONSE DATE FOR EA 91-158

Gentlemen:

Carolina Power & Light Company is in receipt of the Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty - \$125,000 (EA 91-158) for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Units 1 and 2 dated January 3, 1992. The enclosure specifies that a reply is required within 30 days of the date of the Notice.

During a telephone conversation between Mr. K. J. Ahern (CP&L) and Mr. D. M. Verrelli (NRC Region II) on January 30, 1992, it was agreed that the required response date to the Notice would be extended from February 3, 1992 to February 14, 1992. The extension is necessary to allow CP&L time to incorporate additional information concerning another recent related emergency diesel generator issue at the Brunswick Plant.
