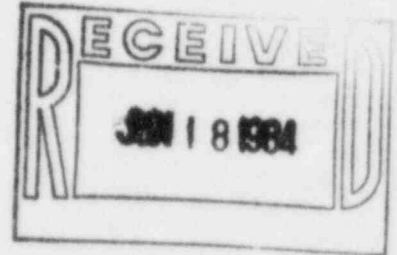

Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter withdraws the potential 10CFR50.55(e) concerning the safety injection accumulators at Wolf Creek Generation Station. This matter was initially reported on March 19, 1984. Additional information was submitted in the reference.

It has been determined through a review of the pressurization records and procedures for the safety injection accumulators and subsequent fracture evaluation performed by the Nuclear Steam Supply System (NSSS) vendor, that the subject procedural deviation as stated in the reference did not affect the integrity of function of the subject tanks. Therefore, KG&E has concluded that this matter is not reportable pursuant to 10CFR50.55(e).
