Automatic Actuation of Shunt Trip Attachments

Dear Sir:

The NRC issued Generic Letter 83-28, "Required Actions Based on Generic Implications of Salem ATWS Events", by letter dated July 8, 1983. Florida Power Corporation's (FPC) response for Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3) was submitted on November 4, 1983.

In our November 4, 1983 response to Position 4.3, FPC committed to provide automatic actuation of each control rod drive trip breaker's shunt trip attachment using a design based upon the Arkansas Power and Light (AP&L) design. The AP&L design was presented to the NRC as a reference design for B&W utilities. The NRC reviewed the AP&L design and issued a Safety Evaluation Report (SER) on September 12, 1983. Enclosure 1 to the SER listed eight items to be addressed on a plant specific basis. On May 30, 1984 FPC responded to the eight plant specific SER items. Responses to items 5, 6, and 8 were commitments to supply a schedule for providing additional information. FPC expects to complete its engineering effort and supply the additional information by July 31, 1984.


